Highlights of the Three Year Old Program

Goal: To learn to work and play with others, including teachers, and promote self help skills and independence, in a loving, safe environment.

Mornings generally begin with:

Playdough, table-top manipulatives, free art and free play to promote sharing, turn taking and working with others.

Group times – provide theme based learning in areas such as sequencing, spatial relations, concepts such as opposites and positional words, shapes and colors, beginning letter/number recognition, name recognition, calendar concepts, categorizing etc. through games, stories, songs, rhymes and finger plays.

Theme topics may include Apples, Community Helpers, Dinosaurs, Fall, Ocean etc.

Outside time is provided daily, weather permitting. Fellowship hall is available during inclement weather, with riding toys, balls, hula hoops, balance beam etc.

Free Play times offer access to blocks and other building materials, home living and dress up, action figures and vehicles, puzzles, books and educational computer games.

Art: Generally theme related and may include process and product oriented projects. Students are exposed to a variety of techniques and media to promote creativity, fine motor development such as cutting and pencil grip; and theme knowledge.

Spiritual Growth: bible stories and verses, biblical concepts such as God's love for us and Jesus as His Son, and prayer. Chapel is attended bi-weekly.

*Music classes are provided twice monthly, Creative Movement is provided once monthly.

*Parents provide a light morning snack and lunch.
