Highlights of the Toddler Program

Goal – to become comfortable separating from parents and receiving care and instructions from other adults.

Daily plans – include time for planned and free play, circle time art, active play, snack and lunch.

Planned play – teacher directed play, encouraging the group to experience the same activity, such as blocks, balls, musical instruments.

Free play – the child's choice of activities, including dolls, housekeeping, vehicles, interactive toys, simple rocking/riding toys.

Circle time – brief times engaging the group in singing familiar and theme-related songs, and fingerplays and reading picture books

Art – an introduction to various media with the goal of showing the child that he/she can create a product. Tools may include brushes, sponges, stamps, stencils, die cuts, foam shapes.

Outside time is provided on a toddler accessible playground.

Teachers are able to spend quality one-on-one time with each child, taking advantage of teachable moments to nurture and instruct.
