

## Mt. Pisgah Weekday School Highlights of the Two Year Old Program

**Goal:** To learn to separate from parents and feel safe with other adults

Mornings generally begin with:

Playdough, manipulatives – to help develop hand-eye coordination, fine motor skill, sorting, sharing/taking turns

**Group time:**

Themes are used to learn and explore areas such as: colors/shapes, visual discrimination, concepts such as opposites, positional words, games to promote following directions.

Theme topics may include: Apples, Pumpkins, Christmas, Winter, Kites, Penguins etc.

Simple songs and rhymes – to promote concepts related to themes as well as alphabet, numbers, seasons, days of week etc.

**Outside time** is provided daily, weather permitting. Fellowship hall is available during inclement weather, with riding toys, balls, balance beam etc.

**Free play** times offer access to blocks, action figures, home living area, vehicles , books etc.

**Art:** Generally theme related – both process and product oriented to develop creativity, fine motor skills, exposure to a variety of media.

**Spiritual Growth:** through bible stories, learning bible verses and blessings as well as learning to pray. Chapel time is attended bi-weekly beginning in January.

\*Music classes are provided twice monthly, Creative Movement once monthly

\*Parents provide a light morning snack and lunch.
